

CONFIGURING YOUR COMPUTER FOR YOUR HOME WIRELESS NETWORK.

In most cases connecting to your home network is done in the same manner whether you have Windows XP or Windows 7.

Turn on your computer and enter your user name and password.

On Windows XP machines using the Dell wireless utility required at BK click Cancel on the Initializing box.

When your computer completes the login process you should see a message in the lower right saying Wireless networks are available.

Clicking on the Wireless icon will open a box with available wireless networks. Your home network should be listed in this box.

Click on your network and click on Connect.

If you have a secured home network you will be prompted for the network key or password. Type this in and press enter. Your computer should now be connected to your home network.

Once you have completed this your computer will remember this connection and will automatically connect each time you turn it on as long as there are no changes to your home network.
